Dress Code for Sixth Formers

Sixth Formers should aim for a smart, professional appearance based on respectability and common sense.

- **Smart suit, including either a skirt or trousers or pinafore dress** – in navy, dark grey or black.
Linen, denim and corduroy are not acceptable materials for school wear. Suits that are likely to fade when washed are also not suitable for school. (Jackets are optional in the 6th Form Study areas and Cafe but must be worn to lessons and around school).
Skirts should be knee length and any design with a vent, should be modest. Tight fitting Capri style trousers are not permitted.
- Denmark Road Sixth Form tie (optional) available from Student Support office.
- **Blouse/Shirts** – white **WITH COLLAR and the collar must be visible**, can be fitted with either long or short sleeves. Long blouses/shirts must be tucked in. Blouses/shirts should be a 'button-through design'.
- **Jumpers** – navy, grey or black crew or V-neck to **coordinate with suit**. Never to be regarded as an alternative to a jacket. **NO SWEATSHIRTS or HOODIES**
- **Outdoor coat** – any smart, dark, plain navy/black/ grey coat, not to worn around school or in lessons.
- **Scarf** – dark in colour and only to be worn in the cold weather with outdoor coat.
- **Shoes** – black or brown only, appropriate and safe; sling backs are not acceptable neither are stiletto/ kitten heels. Any heels with metal tips not allowed. Shoe heels must not be higher than 4 cms. Trainers and plimsolls are not allowed.
- **Jewellery** – no facial or other observable piercings are permitted. Nose studs are not permitted even with a clear stud.
- **Hair** – extreme hairstyles e.g, closely shaven and any non-natural colours are not acceptable.
- **Make-up** – discreet, if worn.
- **Facial hair** – Students are expected to be clean shaven
