The Duke of Edinburgh Award gives students the opportunity to challenge themselves to develop new skills. Throughout the programme they learn many new skills and a lot about themselves! It is a popular option for our 6th Form students. We are a registered centre for the award. The award is run in school by an outdoor education specialist and is supported by teaching and support staff.

Gold – 20 students

Silver - 35 – 40 students

Bronze – 80 - 100 students

Expeditions

Gold – Held in Black Mountains and Brecon Beacons in October & March

Silver – Held in Black Mountains in September & October
